There are warnings of gales in:- Dover, **WIGHT** & Portland.

The General synopsis at midnight:-

High Tyne 1035, expected Forties 1032 by midnight tonight. Low northeast Trafalgar 1008, slow moving with little change by same time. New lows expected south Biscay and southeast Fitzroy, both 1007 by that time.

The Area Forecast for the next 24 hours:-

Dover, Wight & Portland.

Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally **gale 8**. Moderate or rough. Fair. Moderate or good.

INSHORE FORECAST:- Issued by the Met Office, on behalf of the Maritime & Coastguard Agency for coastal areas to 12 miles offshore from Saturday the 25th of March 2017 at 06:00 until Sunday the 26th of March 2017 at 06:00.

The General Situation at 06:00 – Saturday the 25th of March 2017.

Pressure will remain high over the United Kingdom with most places remaining fine and quiet. However, strong pressure gradients on the high's southern flank will maintain a risk of **gales** along English Channel coasts for a time.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill:-

Strong winds are forecast.

24 hour forecast: Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally **gale 8**. Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough. Fair. Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours: Northeasterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later. Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate. Fair. Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis:-

Strong winds are forecast.

24 hour forecast: Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally **gale 8**. Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough. Fair. Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours: East or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally **gale 8** at first. Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate. Fair. Moderate or good.

WEATHER FORECAST. SOUTHEAST ENGLAND 25/03/2017.

Today: After a chilly start, perhaps with short-lived mist or fog patches, widespread and generally unbroken sunshine will lead to a mostly warm day. However a fresh easterly breeze will bring a noticeably cooler feel along eastern coasts. Maximum Temperature 16°C.

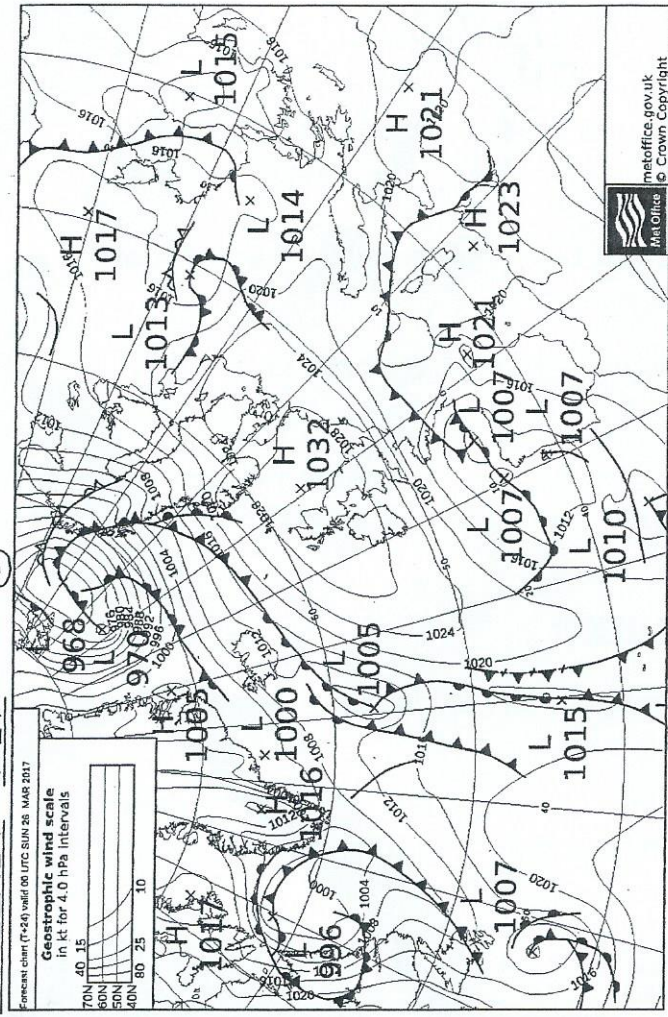
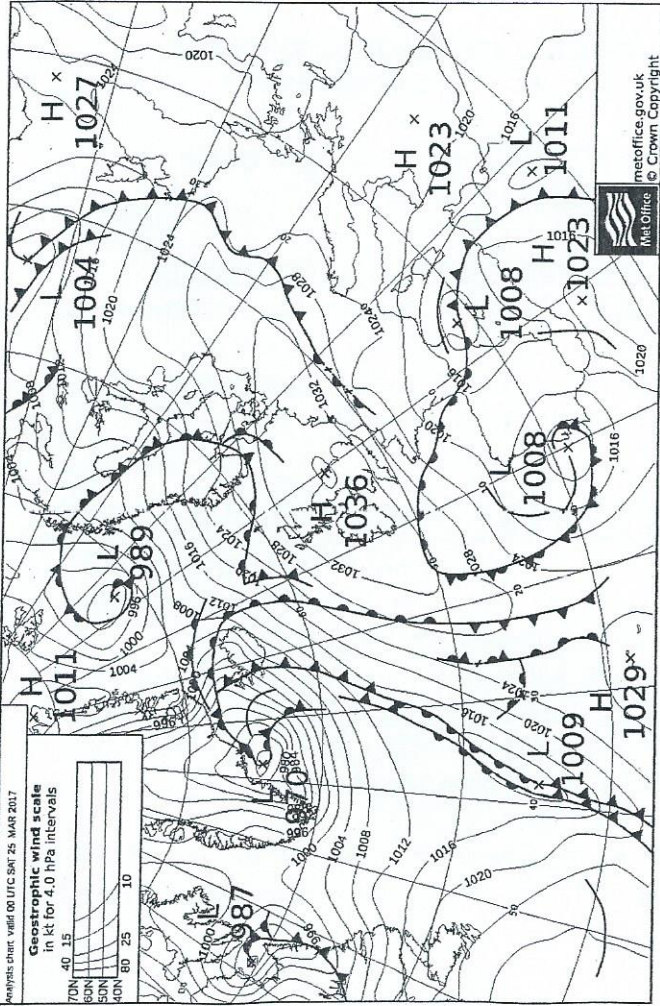
Tonight: After a mostly clear night some low cloud may form towards dawn further east. Light winds inland but staying breezy over Kent and the south coast. Minimum Temperature 4°C.

Sunday: Any early low cloud will clear quite quickly. All parts will stay dry with plenty of sunshine. A brisk easterly breeze will take the edge off coastal temperatures. Maximum Temperature 15°C.

Outlook for Monday to Wednesday: Generally more cloudy than over the weekend with the odd shower or spot of light rain. On *Wednesday* winds will pick up a bit perhaps with some light rain later.
