Viking, North Utsire, South Utsire

Northwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in South Utsire. Rough or very rough. Occasional rain. Moderate or good, occasionally poor

Forties, Cromarty

Northwest 6 to gale 8, veering north 4 or 5 later. Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in northeast Forties. Rain at times. Moderate or good, occasionally poor

Forth, Tyne

Dogger

Northwesterly 6 to gale 8, veering northerly 4 or 5 later. Moderate or rough. Occasional rain. Moderate or good, occasionally poor

Fisher, German Bight

Northwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first in Fisher, veering north 5 or 6 later. Rough or very rough. Occasional rain. Moderate, occasionally poor

Humber, Thames

Northwest 5 or 6. Moderate, occasionally rough in northeast Humber. Mainly fair. Good

Dover, Wight, Portland

Variable, becoming northeast, 3 or 4. Smooth or slight. Fair. Good

Plymouth, Biscay

East 4 or 5. Slight or moderate. Fair. Good

Fitzroy

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west. Moderate or rough. Thundery showers in southwest. Good, occasionally poor

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast: Variable 2 or 3 at first west of Beachy Head, otherwise northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near North Foreland. Smooth or slight. Fair. Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours: Northerly 3 or 4, veering northeasterly 4 or 5 later. Smooth or slight. Showers for a time. Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast: Variable 2 or 3, becoming north or northeast 3 or 4. Smooth or slight. Fair. Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours: North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later. Smooth or slight. Showers for a time. Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

The General Situation at 06:00 – Saturday the 3rd of December 2016.

The centre of an area of high pressure will edge slowly eastwards across the North Sea over the weekend. This will lead to strong easterly winds through both the English Channel and the Bristol Channel, but lighter winds elsewhere.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill:-

Strong winds are forecast.

24 hour forecast: Northeasterly 4 or 5, veering easterly 5 or 6. Slight, becoming moderate. Showers at first. Good, becoming moderate or poor later.
